

Guide to Leachman Bull Offering:

- 🔍 EPDs are Breed Association EPDs on all registered bulls or Leachman based Across Breed Comparisons on all unregistered bulls. All ABCs are on an Angus base and are directly comparable to Angus EPDs.
- 🔍 MWT: Leachman's prediction of the mature weight of daughters produced by the bull.
- 🔍 FG: Leachman EPD that predicts progeny feed to gain ratio in the feedlot. Less is better conversion.
- 🔍 Intake: Leachman EPD that predicts feed intake. Lower means progeny will eat less feed.
- 🔍 YHT: yearling height EPD/ABC of the bull in inches. A bull that will sire 5.5 frame cattle is around a +0.4 YHT
- 🔍 SCR: yearling scrotal EPD/ABC of the bull in cm's. Average bulls (+0.0) have around a 35 cm scrotal.
- 🔍 DSP: Leachman Disposition Score where 5 is very quiet, 3 is average, 2 is nervous, and 1 is wild.
- 🔍 Stars:
 - Calving Ease: 5 stars is extreme easing calving, 4 stars is ideal for heifers, 3 stars is ok for bigger heifers. All bulls without stars are suitable for use on cows.
 - Growth: More stars is more growth. Ranked 5 stars best and 1 star is least.
 - Maternal: Rates daughter profitability. 5 stars is best and 1 star is least.
 - Feedlot: Predicts the profitability of calves by this bull in the feedlot. 5 stars is most profitable and 1 star is less profitable.
 - Kind: Our subjective opinion of the bulls overall phenotypic desirability.
- 🔍 \$Ranch: The Leachman prediction of weaning profitability. Includes cow productivity, cow feed intake, fertility, and growth rate.
- 🔍 \$Profit: The Leachman prediction of birth to slaughter profitability. Includes all traits that effect your bottom line including growth, carcass, fertility, and feed intake.
